Types of noun:

1/Proper noun:

A proper noun is the one that names a particular person, place, or thing

Example: Ahmed, George, Chicago, America, Titanic, January, Algeria.

2/Common noun:

A common noun is a name given in common to every person or thing of the same kind.

Example: book, pen, car, table, door, student, teacher, school, classroom,

3/Abstract noun:

An abstract noun is the name of some qualities, action, or feeling that we can only think or feel but cannot touch or sees

Example: heat, hunger, anger, truth, kindness, modesty, wisdom, patience, honesty, magic, laughter

4/collective noun:

A collective noun is the name of a collective, of persons, or things taken together and spoken of as one whole.

Example:

Herd, crowd, family, team, family, army, bunch, pair, nation.
