1-when we speak we often say things like ALL RIGHT! GOOD! WANT ANY HELP!

These are complete units of meaning; but they are not real sentences.

2-A simple sentences is a complete unit of meaning which contains a subject and a verb.

Followed, if necessary by other words which make up the meaning So:

Made in Germany is correct English but it is not sentence because it doesn't have a subject.

My car was made in Germany .is a complete sentence with subject and verb

We can't say "is tired" because we need a subject "he is tired"
