# Instructions and guidelines

# I. The pdf document:

## i. the cover page

The cover page must contain the university log as well as your full name, the title of your work, the academic year and under whose supervision.

## ii. The Format:

- The text must be well spaced (1.5 line spacing) and paragraphs must be justified.
- The font should be **Garamond 12 point** and the margins should be **3 points on the left** and **2 on the right**.
- The brief should be between 15 and 25 pages long.
- The pages must be numbered, except for the title page.

#### iii. The content

Your work must be organised and consist of:

#### ✓ An abstract.

Your summary should be clear and not exceed 4 lines.

#### ✓ An introduction.

You need to start by introducing the subject in order to define one or more issues. You must: define the subject, the key words and announce your work plan.

## ✓ A development divided into several parts.

- 4 Your development must be clear, so don't make your sentences too long.
- ¥ You need to rework and summarise the information you have found. no copypaste!
- ♣ You can include documents (tables, diagrams, images, etc.).

### ✓ A conclusion

Your conclusion should restate the main points of the development and provide new food for thought on the subject.

## ✓ A bibliography.

A well-constructed bibliographical search must be carried out in order to produce a quality work.

Please note that references must be listed in alphabetical order.

# II. The video talk:

Important guidelines to follow for the video presentation:

- A video summarising the written work, lasting 15 to 20 minutes.
- A brief introduction of the candidate at the beginning of the video containing "Last name, first name and title of presentation".
- Make sure that the video slides are clear.
- Do not read what is written on the slides, you must prepare your speech well.

# III. The speech:

On the day of the oral assessment, the following two points must be respected

- The order of the presentations will be based on a list that will be determined later and made available to you on Moodle.
- The speech should last between 5 and 10 minutes maximum.
