- a) General De Gaulle declared that he had understood us.
- b) Woodrow Wilson's 'Fourteen Points' called for a new approach to International diplomacy. -During the period of the **state** of **war**, the Constitution shall be **suspended**; the **President** of the Republic shall assume **all the powers**. When the **mandate** of the President of the Republic comes to expiry, it **shall be extended** de **jure** until the end of

the war.

c) On 25 April 1945, 50 governments met in San Francisco for a conference and started drafting the UN Charter,

which was adopted on 25 June 1945 and took effect on 24 October 1945.

- d) The United Nations Security Council, through its Counter-Terrorism Committee, has formally adopted Algeria's
 - anti-terrorism financing principles, now officially titled the 'Algeria Guiding Principles.' These guiding
 - principles, unanimously endorsed on Thursday, 2025, mark a pivotal advancement in global counter-terrorism

efforts, reflecting Algeria's profound influence during its 2024-2025 mandate at the UN Security Council.

- e) According to articles 71 of Algeria's Constitution of 2020, the president of the Republic shall have the right
 - to grant pardons, and to reduce or to commute sentences. The High Council of the Judiciary shall provide

consultative opinion to the President of the **Republic** prior to the exercise of the **right** to **pardon**.

f) The UN General Assembly voted overwhelmingly on Friday, May 10th 2024, in support of a Palestinian bid for full

membership of the world body, a symbolic move after the United States vetoed the measure in the Security Council.

The Assembly adopted a resolution with 143 votes in favor and nine against, including the U.S. and Israel, while

25 countries abstained. It does not give the Palestinians full U.N. membership, but simply recognizes them as

qualified to join.

g) Under the leadership of the Algerian Foreign Minister Ahmed Attaf, the 11th High-Level Seminar on Peace and

Security in Africa kicked off on Sunday 2024 in Oran, reaffirming Algeria's pivotal role in advocating for

African unity and collective solutions to the continent's pressing challenges. The seminar explored critical

issues, particularly enhancing coordination between the African Union Peace and Security Council and the A3 to

amplify Africa's voice within the UN Security Council.
