1- Full stop (.)

* All sentences end with a full stop.

*Full stops are considered optional in abbreviations

(i.e.) to explain things, (e.g.) example.

2- Questions mark.(?)

*It is used to ask questions

3- Exclamation mark.(!)

*It is used in strong exclamation.

4-Quotation marks. (“ ”)

*They are used in direct speech.

*With foreign words.

5- Apostrophe.(‘ ’)

*Possessive nouns have apostrophes.

6- Comma (,)

*The comma is a punctuation inside the sentence.

7- Semicolon. (;)

*It is used between two clauses that could be separated sentences, especially when the clauses are linked in sense or contrasted

8- A Colon. (:)
