In criminal law, no **one** may be punished without an existing legal provision: offences and **penalties** must be clearly **defined** by law. Theft, as a fraudulent act, is subject to **criminal** sanctions such as fines or imprisonment. Offences such as fraud or **breach** of trust (for example, the misappropriation of funds entrusted under a commercial contract) are likewise punishable under criminal law. Honesty is a **fundamental** value that distinguishes criminal illegality from ordinary civil irregularities, such as a delay in delivery or a failure to perform a contractual obligation without fraudulent intent.
