Summary of the article

This article tackles a comparative analysis of the pronunciation of engineers and bureaucrats using an **explanatory research design**. The purpose of the instant study is to find out the factors influencing pronunciation of English in their community. For this reason, two types of important professional fields from the community were taken for experiment which are Bureaucrats and Engineers. Similarly, two types of research tools are adopted. First, Afshan, Ali and Saeed (2021) used observation sheet, and second a structured open-ended survey. The findings show different aspects of both groups. It can be noted that both engineers and bureaucrats can greatly benefit from good pronunciation in English language. However, if we consider the nature of their roles, bureaucrats might need for negotiation skills, because they often have to communicate with a great range of people including stakeholders, and the public. Or this reason, they look to use clear pronunciation to ensure their messages are understood and to potentially avoid any misunderstanding.
